Cross Country Course- the course remains closed to all riders at this time due to it remaining very wet and the associated safety issues. We don't want the take off and landing zones around the jumps being bogged up as it is a big job to fill holes. We also want to put gravel in front of the majority of jumps before riders start using it again to ensure it is safe. Updates re the grounds will be posted via email.

Keys to the grounds- are again being sorted. BMPC members keys will open the gate at the sporting horse area and 2 gates along the sand arena. Therefore everyone using the BMPC area in between rallies will need to enter via the campdraft area and park at the day yards. Please remember to lock the grounds when you leave.

Day Yards- please clean the day yards of any manure after use but don't put the manure on the trees (natives don't like it!). There will be an area allocated and marked for manure.

Gradings- the DC and Chief Instructor are currently reviewing gradings. It is the riders responsibility to make sure that their cards are correctly graded when entering a competition. For any problems, please see Toni.
