

BACCHUS MARSH PONY CLUB INC. GROUNDS AND MEMBERS KEY POLICY

GROUNDS:

The Bacchus Marsh Pony Club Grounds are locked between rallies and pony club activities.

Financial members of the Bacchus Marsh Pony Club can request a key to the grounds.

Adult Non Pony Club Members wanting to school horses on the Pony Club Grounds will have to take out an Adult Pony Club Membership, so they can have a key. Conditions in this Policy will apply to them.

The Key to the grounds is for members use only.

The key is not to be lent to other people wanting to access the Pony Club Grounds.

Junior Members, Associate Members and Adult Members are to have someone with them at all times when using the grounds.

Members are asked to watch the calendar and newsletter in case the grounds are being used by another group.

Riders are not to use the grounds on a day of "Total Fireban".

The Cross Country course will be closed 4 weeks prior to the Bacchus Marsh Horse Trials - 3rd Sunday in March and 3rd Sat/Sun July - this applies to members and others using the Reserve.

The Cross Country Course may be closed at other times during the year for maintenance - members will be notified.

Members are asked when using the grounds and find any safety issues - damage to cross country fences or anything else that is broken and needs addressing if they could email the Club Secretary, so it can be put on the Agenda to be addressed at the next meeting.

ALL MEMBERS ARE ASKED WHEN USING THE GROUNDS PLEASE DON'T PARK BETWEEN THE PONY CLUB SHED, THE POULTRY SHED AND THE WATER TANKS - THIS IS A HORSE/HORSE FLOAT FREE AREA AND IS A REQUEST BY THE RESERVE'S COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT NOT THE PONY CLUB. TO ENSURE HARMONY WITH THE PONY CLUB AND OTHER USERS OF THE RESERVE, PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU OBSERVE THIS REQUEST AT ALL TIMES.

OTHER AREAS OUT OF BOUNDS FOR HORSES ARE:

The front of the Grandstand and the Pony Club Shed.

Members are asked to ensure they lock the Grounds when leaving.

When the Pony Club Membership lapses, the key is to be returned to the club.
