- PCAV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCAV rules may be left uninsured
- The organizing committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition: divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
  - All Riders must complete a Liability Declaration form
- \$10 Day attendance Fee is due UNLESS you are a financial member\* of EV/EA; AHS; SHCA;AERA; an Interstate Pony Club; or can prove personal liability cover of at least \$10,000,000.
  - Must Produce proof**
    - Gear check will be required
  - All riders must wear complying helmets. Spot checks to ensure compliance may occur.
  - Medical armbands are required to be worn by all competitors (including non pc members)
  - All Lunging must take place in the round yard or camp draft arena.
  - Queries, protests, horse abuse and doping rules as per the PCAV handbook of by-laws.
    - No Dogs allowed on grounds
      - No stallion, colts or rigs
- Neither the organizing committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, rider, ground spectators or any other person or property
  - The Judges decision is final
  - Pcav Alcohol Policy applies
  - Each rider may ride one or more horses but each horse is restricted to 5 rounds of jumping for the day
    - In ring 1 you can compete in 2 heights only

# Ring 1

## Open Showjumping

Entry \$10.00 per class maximum of 2 classes per horse

Prize for 1<sup>st</sup> sponsored by Pegasus Farm and Stockfeed rosettes to 4th

### All classes are run as a super 2 phase

1. This Competition comprises two phases run without interruption, each at an identical or different speed, the finishing line for the first phase being identical with the starting line for the second phase.
2. The first phase is a course of seven to nine obstacles with or without combinations. The second phase takes place over four to six obstacles, which may include one combination.
3. Art. 274.5.6 Unless eliminated, riders penalised in the first phase may continue in the second phase.

First Phase	Second Phase	Placing
5.6. Table A not against the clock Minimum 5 obstacles Maximum 7 obstacles in first phase	Table A Against the clock Remaining obstacles (Total of minimum 11 and maximum 13 obstacles in both phases.)	According to the aggregate penalties in both phases (faults on obstacles and penalties for exceeding the time allowed in both phases) and, if necessary, according to the time of the 2 <sup>nd</sup> phase.

**Class 1 - 45cm** max height 45cm max width 45cm

**Class 2 - 60cm** max height 60cm max width 60cm

**Class 3 - 75cm** max height 75cm max width 75cm

**Class 4 - 90cm** max height 90cm max width 90cm

**Class 5 - 105cm** max height 105cm max width 105cm
